This project aims to address erosion and hillside washout near the outfall on Monocacy Street. The scope of services includes the installation of one M-Top inlet, two C-Top inlets, three manholes, an end wall, and an outfall rock apron. Additionally, the project will involve the installation of 24-inch and 18-inch reinforced concrete piping and the regrading of a portion of Venus Street to ensure positive drainage.
