Capital Program (RACP) Grant – Bethlehem Emergency Shelter

Attached is a resolution in support of the City's application for the Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program (RACP) Grant through the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The grant request is for \$2,000,000, which, if awarded, will be used for capital improvements to the Bethlehem Emergency Shelter.

The Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program (RACP) is a Commonwealth of Pennsylvania grant program for construction projects exceeding \$1 million in cost. To the benefit of the residents of the City of Bethlehem, many projects have received RACP grants through the years. Active RACP projects in the City include Martin Tower, the National Museum of Industrial History's 2nd Floor expansion, and the LVH – Muhlenberg ICU.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Bethlehem will assume the full local share of the project costs, which will be in excess of the \$2,000,000 grant, and also assume responsibility for the project's ongoing operating and maintenance costs;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk of the City of Bethlehem is directed to execute a certificate attesting to the adoption of this Resolution and to furnish a copy of the Resolution to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
