Reasons for recommendation of Administration and Council approval of contract:

Change Orders 1 and 2 combined exceed 10% of the original contract value. Change Order No. 1 was needed to address unforeseen site conditions and interferences found during installation of yard piping and hydrants. As-found conditions did not match original plant drawings. Change Order No. 2 is a City requested change to add a bypass line for potable water back-up in the event the new non-potable water system is down for maintenance. The Department recommends approval of the cost increase.
