The contract shall run through December 31, 2019.

• Description of project or scope of services to be provided:

Consultant shall provide engineering services for review of the City's Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan. The scope of work shall include: a review of the current Plan which was developed in the 2002-2007 time frame and approved by PaDEP in 2012; an analysis of current waste water treatment and collection system operating conditions; evaluate WWTP wet-stream process alternatives for plant expansion; evaluate wet-weather operations and high flow management plan; review city and contributing municipality requirements for future collection and treatment capacity needs; offer recommendations for future planning efforts and treatment plant upgrades; meet with PaDEP to discuss findings and to consider NPDES permit and Act 537 Plan Update implications.
