Farm Share Details 2023

We, the farm, wish to provide you with fresh, locally grown, seasonal food and you, the member, wish to receive a portion of the harvest. This agreement outlines our shared commitments to that relationship.

Our Farm Share program runs 17 weeks, from the week of July 11, 2022 through October 31, 2022. Members are responsible for picking up their share of freshly harvested produce each week at the pick-up site. You will generally receive 5-6 different fruits/vegetables in a half share and 8-9 different fruits/vegetables in a whole share. Variety and quantity may vary depending on the growing season.

We promise to do our best to provide you with a bountiful share each week. The below chart is our best estimate of the expected Harvest.

Harvest Month	Expected Crops
July -- August	Lettuce, Spinach, Peas, Cabbage, Carrots, Radish, Broccoli, Turnips, Blueberries, Strawberries, Apricots, Cherries Zucchini, Beans, Cucumbers, Lettuce, Beets, Carrots, Onions, Potatoes, Tomatoes, Melons, Peppers, Eggplant, Peaches, Apples, Pears, Plums
September -- October	Sweet Potatoes, Tomatoes, Peppers, Eggplant, Squash, Broccoli, Lettuce, Apples, Pears
*Add on items	Fruit Butters, Syrup, Apples Cider

Bechdolt's will offer a Farm Stand offering additional produce at the CSA pick-up site. You will have the option to purchase these items *in addition* to the produce you receive in your weekly share.

By making a purchase of a CSA Full Share or Half Share, I agree to observe the following rules at the CSA pick up site:

1. Pick up your share within the timeframe stated. Please notify Bechdolt Orchards ([Farm Market Manager, Denise Filo at 610.554.2960 or denisefilo@yahoo.com](#)) if you will be late or will not be picking up your share.
2. You will be required to sign for your produce each week.
3. Be respectful of our host's drop off site.
4. Missed pick-ups will be forfeited unless advanced arrangements are made for an alternate pickup.
5. No refunds will be given for missed pickups.

By purchasing a CSA share, I agree to purchase the membership share indicated. I understand that I am committing to pick up my share on a weekly basis for the entire season during normal pick-up hours. I understand that if I do not pick up my share, I will forfeit the weekly delivery and will not receive a refund. I understand that, although unlikely, the farm may change parts of this agreement related to production and distribution from time to time. I understand that they will contact me in advance of any changes of this agreement.





Christmas City CSA FAQ's

- 1. How much does a full share cost? How much does a half share cost?**
 - A full share costs \$30.00 per week and a half share costs \$20.00 per week.
- 2. May I pay for my entire share at the beginning of the season?**
 - Yes. Members who pay for their entire share up front will save \$30 on full shares and \$20 on half shares.
- 3. I would like a full share but don't know if I can commit to the full 17 weeks. What can I do?**
 - Some members choose to split their share with a friend or family member. They split the cost of the share and pick up on alternate weeks.
- 4. I am going on vacation. What should I do with my share?**
 - You may have a friend or family member pick it up or please contact the Farm Market Manager, Denise Filo at 610.554.2960 or denisefilo@yahoo.com
- 5. I cannot or forgot to pick up my share this week. May I pick it up another day?**
 - We understand that emergencies happen. If you cannot pick up your farm share, please contact Farm Market Manager, Denise Filo at 610.554.2960 or denisefilo@yahoo.com.
