

ELECTRICAL PERMITS - FEE SCHEDULE

RESIDENTIAL

Fee for installation of Electrical Systems in a new single family dwelling, the fee per dwelling unit will be: \$115.00

Service change not over 200 amp. 50.00
Each additional meter 15.00
Service change not over 400 amp. 90.00

Minor Alterations
One (1) to four (4) devices 50.00

Alterations, Additions, or Rewire Entire House
Five (5) or more devices, including service 90.00

Heating, Air Conditioners, Ranges, Water Heaters and Similar Equipment

Per single unit \$ 50.00
Each additional unit 15.00

Swimming Pools - Private

Above ground pool 50.00
Permanent pool 80.00

Public Pools, & Spas

Three (3) year inspection - State required 125.00

Non-Residential Work

Fee for installation of Electrical Systems in all other use groups, buildings new and remodeled, including Emergency Alarm Device, Smoke detectors, Computer wiring, or Phone Systems is as follows: 1.2% up to \$30,000.00 cost of work plus .6% of cost of work over \$30,000.00 with the minimum fee of \$90.00

Yearly Permit Fees - Large scale industrial and Institutional

Large-scale industries and institutions that have a Master Electrician on their staff shall pay a yearly fee of \$350.00. This fee shall cover all of the maintenance work performed in that year. All new construction shall be covered under the fee schedule in Section 1703.03.

Nursing Homes

Three (3) year State required
minimum per hour or part thereof 75.00

Additional Reinspections

(Two or more) will be charged per reinspection visit 75.00

Add state imposed training fee to every permit issued (\$4.50)
