303.01 LICENSES AND PERMITS; FEE.

(a) All persons except as hereinafter provided in subsection (b) engaged in the following trades, businesses, occupations, or activities shall obtain a business license or permit and pay to the City Treasurer the following fees:

(1)	(A) Bus Companies	\$ 35.00 per bus
	(B) Taxicab Companies	\$ 25.00 per taxicab
(2)	Carnivals and circuses except those for religious, educa- tional or charitable purposes	\$100.00 per year
(3)	Food Service Establishments	\$1.00 per year
(4)	Peddlers and solicitors of bread, meat, vegetables and food articles	\$10.00 per day
(5)	Peddlers and solicitors of goods, wares, or merchandise	\$10.00 per day
(6)	Operas, shows, circuses and all kinds of public exhibitions for pay except those of religious, educational or charitable purposes	\$100.00 per year
(7)	Utility Companies (including gas, electric, telephone and telegraph)	\$100.00 per year
(8)	Alarm Monitor Equipment	\$100.00 per

303.02 TERM.

All licenses or permits, unless otherwise indicated herein, shall be issued on an annual basis for the calendar year, renewable each January, and the fees set forth in Section 303.01 are due and payable on March 1 of each year and are not subject to proration of a part thereof. 303.99 PENALTY.

Any person who violates any provision of this article shall be fined six hundred dollars (\$600.00) or imprisoned not more than ninety days, or both. (Ord. 1768 §1. Passed 11/13/62; Ord. 3242. Passed 2/7/89.)
