I have reviewed draft Article 735 Emergency Alarm System with Councilman DiGiacinto on December 31, 2010.

The following modifications are offered:


1. 735.04(1), should be changed from three (3) business days to seven (7) business days.
2. 735.04(4), should be deleted and amended to read as follows; "The names, addresses, and telephone numbers of at least two (2) persons who are authorized to respond to an emergency and gain access to the address where the device is installed."
3. 735.05(a)(1), should be changed from three (3) business days to seven (7) business days.
4. 735.09(b), should be amended to set forth a 30 day appeal period after receipt of notice.
5. 735.11(a), should be amended from not less seven (7) days to not less than fifteen (15) days.
6. 735.11(b), the first sentence should be deleted and read "A registration update form... if not renewed".
7. 735.11(e), should be deleted.
8. 735.99, should delete the "imprisonment" penalties and paragraph a(2) should be changed to a \$200.00 monetary fine, and a(3) should be changed to a \$500.00 monetary fine.

9. 735.99(b) and (c), should be deleted.
