
SUBJECT: RESOLUTION: PA Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR)

4. Any amendment to the Grant Agreement may be signed on behalf of the grantee by the Official who, at the time of signing of the amendment, has the **TITLE** specified in paragraph 1 and the grantee will be bound by the amendment.
