

MUNICIPAL ADVERTISEMENT
CITY OF BETHLEHEM

Notice is hereby given that the Bethlehem City Council has received a Petition for Curative Amendment from BAHX, LLC ("Applicant"), challenging the substantive validity of Article 1322.03(II)4 of the City's Zoning Ordinance, which provides in its entirety as follows:

Except within the IR-R and CB zoning districts, no building shall exceed 180 feet in length, measured at ground level or any floor level, whether on one frontage, or on the combined frontages of the main frontage and that of any wings of the same building.

Applicant has proposed a curative amendment, pursuant to which Bethlehem City Council conducted a public hearing on Tuesday, April 30, 2024. A second public hearing will be conducted on Wednesday, July 31, 2024 at 6:00 p.m. in Town Hall, located at 10 E. Church Street, Bethlehem, Pennsylvania, 18018, to consider "An Ordinance of the City of Bethlehem, Counties of Lehigh and Northampton, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Amending Zoning Ordinance Section 1322.02(II) to Amend Provisions for Multi-Family Dwellings in the CB and CL Zoning Districts," which provides in its entirety as follows:

Except within the IR-R, CB and CL zoning districts, no building shall exceed 180 feet in length, measured at ground level or any floor level, whether on one frontage, or on the combined frontages of the main frontage and that of any wings of the same building.

The full proposed text of said ordinance may be examined by any citizen at the Bethlehem City Hall, located at 10 E. Church Street, Bethlehem, Pennsylvania, 18018, Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:15 p.m. until the date of the aforesaid City Council Meet-
