



- 1. THE CONTRACTOR MUST VERIFY THE LOCATION AND DEPTH OF ALL PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION. CALL
- 2. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL FIELD STAKE THE EXTENTS OF THE NEW STEPS AND EXPANDED PLANTING BED FOR REVIEW BY THE OWNER
- 3. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR OBTAINING ANY AND ALL LOCAL PERMITS AND APPROVALS FOR THE SUCCESSFUL
- 4. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL RESTORE DISTURBED OR DAMAGED SURROUNDS OF THE WORK AREA TO A PRE-CONSTRUCTION CONDITION.

5. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SUBMIT SHOP DRAWINGS TO THE OWNER, OR ITS REPRESENTATIVE, FOR ALL OF THE FOLLOWING ELEMENTS:

-HAND RAILINGS -CAST STONE CAPS

- 6. BASED UPON AVAILABILITY OF STONE PRODUCTS, THE CONTRACTOR MAY SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING ALTERNATIVES, LISTED IN ORDER OR PRIORITY:

- BLUESTONE 2. 4" CAST STONE
- STEP TREADS: **FINISHED**
- **BLUESTONE** 2. 6-7/8" MONO-**BLOCK FLAME FINISHED BLUESTONE**




PLANTING NOTES:

- THE CONTRACTOR MUST VERIFY LOCATION AND DEPTH OF ALL UNDERGROUND UTILITIES AND FACILITIES PRIOR TO BEGINNING CONSTRUCTION. CALL PENNSYLVANIA ONE-CALL 811 AND UTILITY LOCATOR SERVICE AS REFERENCED IN THE PROJECT MANUAL.
- 2. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL LAYOUT AND REVIEW ALL PLANT MATERIAL AND PLANT LOCATIONS WITH THE OWNER'S REPRESENTATIVE PRIOR TO INSTALLATION.
- 3. ALL AREAS DISTURBED DURING PLANTING ACTIVITY SHALL BE ESTABLISHED AS PERMANENT LAWN WITH THE SPECIFIED SEED MIX OR THE APPROPRIATE VEGETATIVE COVER PER THE SEEDING SCHEDULE AND PLANTING PLAN.
- 4. SUBSTITUTIONS: WHEN PLANTS OF A SPECIFIED TYPE OR SIZE ARE NOT AVAILABLE WITHIN A REASONABLE DISTANCE, SUBSTITUTIONS MAY BE MADE UPON REQUEST BY THE CONTRACTOR, IF APPROVED BY THE OWNER'S REPRESENTATIVE. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE OWNER'S REPRESENTATIVE IN WRITING OF ANY PLANT MATERIALS THAT HE FEELS WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE, PRIOR TO SUBMITTING A BID ON THIS PROJECT. IF A BID IS RECEIVED WITHOUT SUCH QUALIFICATION, IT WILL BE ASSUMED NO SUCH SUBSTITUTIONS WILL BE PROPOSED.
- 5. PLANTS WITH BROKEN ROOT BALLS OR EXCESSIVE DAMAGE TO THE CROWN SHALL BE REPLACED PRIOR TO INSTALLATION.
- 6. MULCH FOR SHRUBS, AND GROUNDCOVER SHALL BE DOUBLE SHREDDED, HARDWOOD BARK MULCH; DARK BROWN IN COLOR; AGED AT LEAST ONE YEAR, AND CLEAN AND FREE OF WEEDS ON ALL DESIGNATED AREAS.
- 7. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL APPLY A PRE-EMERGENT WEED KILLER, PREEN (OR APPROVED EQUAL), TO TOPSOIL PRIOR TO MULCHING ACTIVITIES. WATER ACTIVATE IF NECESSARY.
- 8. SHRUBS IN LEAF WHEN PLANTED SHALL BE TREATED WITH ANTI-DESSICANT SUCH AS WILT-PROOF.
- 9. PREPARATION OF PLANTING SOIL: BEFORE MIXING, CLEAN TOPSOIL OF ROOTS, VEGETATION, STONES, CLAY LUMPS, AND OTHER EXTRANEOUS MATERIALS GREATER THAN OR EQUAL TO ONE INCH IN SIZE AND HARMFUL TO PLANT GROWTH. PLANTING SOIL FOR TREES, SHRUBS, AND GROUNDCOVER SHALL BE A MIXTURE BY VOLUME OF THE FOLLOWING:

50% SUBSOIL / 20% ORGANIC MATTER / 30% TOPSOIL

10. THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ADJUSTMENTS TO SOIL PH, FERTILITY, AND/OR DRAINAGE CONDITIONS NECESSARY TO ENSURE PROPER GROWING CONDITIONS FOR PROPOSED PLANTINGS






GROUNDCOVER AND DAFFODIL BULB PLANTING AND SPACING DETAIL

11. FIELD CONDITIONS MAY DICTATE MINOR ADJUSTMENTS TO THE LOCATION OF PLANT MATERIAL. BEFORE MAJOR ADJUSTMENTS OF PLANT LOCATIONS OCCUR, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE OWNER OR HIS REPRESENTATIVE.

- 12. THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR WATERING. WEEDING, FERTILIZING, AND MAINTAINING ALL NEWLY PLANTED VEGETATION FOR A PERIOD OF SIXTY DAYS AFTER PLANTING. A WATER SOURCE IS AVAILABLE ON
- 13. ANY PLANT WITH A CUT LEADER WILL BE REJECTED.
- 14. THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR INSTALLATION OF PLANT MATERIAL AT THE APPROPRIATE TIME OF YEAR.
- 15. ALL NEW PLANT MATERIAL SHALL BE WARRANTED FOR A PERIOD OF 18 MONTHS FROM DATE OF FINAL ACCEPTANCE.
- 16. ALL PLANTS SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE AMERICAN STANDARD FOR NURSERY STOCK, LATEST EDITION, UNLESS NOTED OTHERWISE IN THE PLANT SCHEDULE.
