The contract shall run from the Notice to Proceed until June 30, 2020 for Tasks I through VII and until March 31, 2021 for Task VIII.

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• Description of project or scope of services to be provided:

The preparation of the 2020 PA PUC Major Water Rate Case filing documents will include exhibits and direct testimony in response to the list of filing requirements including: Task I – Valuation – Rate Base, Original Cost and Depreciation Study Task II- Rate of Return – Analysis of capital structure, development of debt and fund equity, risk considerations and financial analysis, calculate overall rate of return.

Task III- Revenue Requirements – Development of pro forma statements of income and revenue requirements, Balance Sheet and Operating Statement for historic and future test years.

Task IV – Cost of Service Allocation and Rate Structure – Development of Consumption Analysis, Cost of Service Allocation, Rate Design and Rate Application. Provide required signs and customer notice language.

Task V – Quality of Service – Organize City's responses for filing purposes.

Task VI – Address Items from Prior Rate Case Order – Meter Calibration, Meter Replacement, evaluate separate industrial rate structure, accuracy of categorizing nonresidential customers by class, incorporate Demand Study results into testimony of Task IV. Task VII – Review Other Tariff Water Fees. Review current charges for sufficiency and identify other fess for additional services.

Task VIII – Post-Filing Services – Respond to interrogatories, review opposing testimony, prepare rebuttal testimony, participate in settlement proceedings and attend evidentiary hearings.

  - Gannett Fleming has maintained and updated the database which includes the original cost of plant installed by year for over 100 years for each type of plant account.
  - Gannett Fleming calculates the remaining life depreciation using their proprietary software based on service life estimates for each plant account that have been approved by the PA PUC.
  - The Gannett Fleming Project Team has from 3 to 34 years of experience in the varied aspects of PA PUC water rate case filings.
