CASE #720 -- It is proposed to replace the roof at 733 East Fourth Street.

The Commission upon motion by Mr. Hudak and seconded by Mr. Evans adopted the proposal that City Council issue a Certificate of Appropriateness for the proposed work as presented, with modifications described herein:

- 1. The proposal to replace the roof was presented by John Counterman.
- 2. Approved replacement roof includes the following details:
 - a. New shingles at the front (south) roof landscape are GAF Slateline asphalt roof shingles in 'Antique Gray' color; the rear (north) roof landscape is to be replaced with new dimensional shingles in a dark color.
 - b. The new aluminum drip edge along the eave line is to be painted to match existing trim.
 - c. The existing (failing) rake boards are to be repaired/replaced in-kind.
 - d. New flashing at the existing chimney is to be fabricated from copper.
 - e. New vent stacks are to be cut into the rear roof landscape, near the peak but not visible from the front roof landscape.
 - f. Existing gutters and downspouts are to be retained.

The motion for the proposed work was unanimously approved.
