The Police Department is applying to receive up to \$41,034.00 in funding through the 2020 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG). The grant will be used by the Police Department to continue improvements to computer hardware and software.

In order to receive and use these funds, the purpose and use of the funds must be made available for review by City Council. In the past, council has drafted and passed a resolution in support of this grant. I am requesting this communication be addressed at the next City Council meeting.

As in past years, these funds will be used to upgrade the department's computer hardware, software, and peripherals. Specifically, we will be renewing our subscription to PowerDMS document management software, which is used for accreditation and managing department directives, training, and certifications. We will also be utilizing the funds to purchase replacement ruggedized laptops and mounts for use in the patrol vehicle fleet as well as label printers, print ribbon, and paper for our digital report/property management system.

A public hearing must be held to give interested persons opportunity to comment regarding the funding to be received by the Police Department. Therefore, I am requesting the proposed resolution be read into the record when appropriate. This will allow for the required opportunity for public comment.
