The Board upon motion by Phil Roeder and seconded by Derrick Clark adopted the proposal that City Council issue a Certificate of Appropriateness for the following:

- 1. The decking shall be either wood or composite. If wood, shall be manufactured of cedar, Spanish cedar or mahogany and ¾" thick by 2-3/4" wide. If composite, shall be manufactured by Aeratis and 3-18" wide or by Azek and will be 3-3/8" wide.
- 2. The color of the decking material shall be a medium to dark grey.
- 3. Composite skirtboard shall be grey in color and the decking shall overhand the skirtboard by $\frac{3}{4}$ " to 1".
- 4.. The deck shall be modified and box-outs around the window shall be installed for ventilation.
- 5. The fence shall be moved away approximately 3" to 6" and approved by the Zoning Officer.
- 6. Applicant must complete modifications within 60 days from the approval of C.O.A. and must notify Mr. Roeder and/or the Historic Officer, Mr. Phillips, when the work is completed.
