The Department of Community and Economic Development is recommending a Substantial Amendment to the 2019 CDBG Action Plan.

In accordance with CDBG program regulations, the City is allowed to make substantial amendments to its Annual Action Plan and Budget in accordance with the City's Citizen Participation Plan.

In response to the COVID-19 infectious disease disaster, the City of Bethlehem has received \$649,643 of entitlement funds through the Federal CARES Act. It is necessary to incorporate the CARES Act into the FY 2019 Action Plan in order to receive and implement the funds. The new activities will become part of the FY 2019 Action Plan using funds to prevent, prepare for and respond to COVID-19 in the City of Bethlehem. This is considered a substantial amendment in accordance with Bethlehem's Citizen Participation Plan as the following applies: 7. Criteria for Amendment to Programs 3. Activities proposed to be added or deleted from the plan.

The amendment to the FY 2019 CDBG Annual Action Plan is proposed as follows:
