Summer Programming

- Provide free summer programming for residents in all geographic locations of the City
- Work with partners in both the City and community to offer a more diversified curriculum (Police, Health Bureau, Fire, EMS, CAT, LVHN, etc.)
- (Future) Incorporate local college education programs to enhance instruction. (A connection has already been made with a representative from Moravian College.)
- (Future) Partner with St. Luke's Health Network and Five Star Heart Non-Profit to provide financial assistance to residents with financial need to attend summer camps at Municipal Ice Rink

Winter Programming:

- (Future) Partner with (Police) to provide free skating instruction to youth residents with financial need.
- (Future) Schedule ice time for residents with physical and mental disabilities.

Park/Improvements

- Work with CED Department on various grants, including CDBG, to improve park facilities
- Work with organizations such as CAT (Coalition for Appropriate Transportation) and community volunteers to create new recreation opportunities in our parks and facilities
- Work with City Grounds, Facilities, and Traffic Bureaus to utilize their services to enhance our programming and offerings

- Attend activity and wellness fairs in the community to inform residents of recreation opportunities
