WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2017-069 of the City Council of the City of Bethlehem (Council) provides procedures concerning the acceptance of gifts of real estate; and

WHEREAS, no deed may be accepted until Council has authorized a Resolution to accept the gifted real estate; and
