• Term of contract or estimated completion date, subject to standard extensions:

The contract is for the creation of two seasonal newsletters, the Fall/Winter 2021 and the Spring/Summer 2022 issues.

• Description of project or scope of services to be provided:

Hometown Press is a division of Community Business Network, a multifaceted publishing, marketing and advertising sales company that has been working with and representing community institutions and businesses for over 20 years.

Hometown Press works with many municipalities and offers full service printing and production of community newsletters. Their business model is to offset the cost of printing by selling advertising in the newsletter. The cost of advertising ranges from \$295 to \$1,395 depending on the size of the ad and allows businesses to be included in a newsletter that is mailed to every residence in the city. That model allows the printing of the newsletter to be free to the municipality. The only cost that continues to be borne by the municipality is the postage associated with the newsletter.

• State the actual or estimated price to the City or the proposed Department budget allowance for the initial term; and state payment rate per unit of service if applicable:

An estimated total cost of \$14,713.60 of the postage for the mailing of 66,792 newsletters (33,396 Fall / 33,396 Spring) based on current postage rates.

 Maximum dollar value of all renewals provided for beyond the original term as if all renewals were exercised:

\$45,000 (estimated) three annual renewals

• Reasons for recommendation of Administration and Council approval of contract:

Currently, the City of Bethlehem produces two seasonal newsletters a year. The newsletter contains relevant community information and required residential notifications. For Fall 2020/ Spring 2021 the City partnered with Hometown Press. The cost of printing 33,396 copies per seasonal issue is free and the cost of handling is \$698 plus an estimated \$6,320 for postage per seasonal issue, for an estimated total cost of \$14,036 for both Fall/Spring issues under current postage rates.

It is recommended that the City contract with Hometown Press to produce the two newsletters scheduled for Fall/Winter 2020 and Spring/Summer 2021.

Please approve this recommendation by passing the accompanying resolution. A vote of final approval is requested at the first City Council agenda listing of this matter.
