Attached is a resolution to support the submission of a PennDOT grant application for a Multimodal grant for the implementation of the Broad Street Active Transportation Plan.

The proposed scope of work includes the development of the missing median in the block of Broad Street between Guetter and New Streets, extension of the median from Center to Penn Streets and intersection improvements at High, Maple and Elm Streets.

The entire project costs are approximately \$1.4 million dollars. The grant requires a 30% match that will come from CDBG funds, developer contributions and the existing funds available for street tree installation. The grant request amount is \$985,500.
