Bethlehem received a grant to support the East & West Broad St. Alternative Transportation Infrastructure upgrade. The project proposes the development of an active transportation plan for pedestrian, bicycle and transit infrastructure improvements. The study runs from Hanover Ave. to Steko Blvd.

The University of Pittsburgh will be granting the City of Bethlehem \$20,000 for this project.

Projected revenue and expenses associated with this grant were not included in the 2021 Budget. It is our recommendation that the following budget adjustments be considered for approval. Since this is a new project and this is a new revenue source we request that a revenue account be created and the expenditure be adjusted.
