Re: Health Budget Amendments

Please have City Council's Finance Committee consider the following amendments:

- 1. Increase expenditure account 0302-42177, Immunization, by \$ 20,000 from \$ 171,933 to \$ 191,933 due to receipt of subsequent available funding for COVID promotion and advertising.
  - a. Increase revenue account 001-30402, Grants and Gifts City Health, by \$20,000 from \$2,376,000 to \$2,396,000.
- 2. Increase expenditure account 0302-42070, Clinic Services, by 5,000 from \$ 77,000 to \$ 82,000 to replace monies transferred from clinic services to the immunization account.
  - a. Increase revenue account 001-30402, Grants and Gifts City Health, by \$5,000 from \$2,396,000 to 2,401,000.
- 3. Increase expenditure account 0302-42190 E, Chronic Disease Escrow, by 8,000 from \$7,525 to \$15,525 due to a switch in funding accounts for farm stand programs.
  - a. Increase revenue account 001-30402, Grants and Gifts City Health, by \$8,000 from \$2,401,000 to 2,409,000.
- 4. Increase expenditure account 0302-42180, Safe and Healthy Communities by \$20,000 from \$86,300 to \$106,300 due to receipt of subsequent available funding.
  - a. Increase revenue account 001-30402, Grants and Gifts City Health, by \$20,000 from \$2,409,000 to \$2,429,000.
