Please accept this memo as a formal request of City Council to adopt a resolution in support of an application to the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development for a Covid-19 ARPA H2O PA Grant. This program is managed by the Commonwealth Financing Authority.

The grant will be used to help fund a project to replace the 2-million-gallon Southwest Reservoir located on an access road along Mountain Drive North in Lower Saucon Township. This project will replace the nearly 100-year-old reservoir with a 1-million-gallon tank and allow for demolition of the reservoir (built circa 1924). Replacement of this reservoir will improve water quality to existing residential and commercial properties in the City, Upper Saucon Township, and Lower Saucon Township.

As applicant, the City is obligated to provide matching funds of not less than 50% of the amount awarded under the H2O PA grant program. Based on a total project cost estimate of \$1,935,450, the grant request will be for \$1,290,300, and the city's share will be at least 50% of this amount, or \$645,150. Construction is not expected to take place until 2024 at which time the appropriate funds will be budgeted in the water capital account.

I respectfully ask that the attached draft resolution be placed on an upcoming Council meeting agenda in order to meet the filing deadline of December 21, 2022.
