Request Intermunicipal Liquor License Transfer

My Client: CUC Holdings, LLC

Dear Mr. Miller:

Please consider this correspondence as my client's request for an intermunicpal transfer of liquor license into the City of Bethlehem at the above location, pursuant to 47 P.S. § 4-461(b.3). Under this statute, please note that a public hearing (duly advertised) must be held by the municipal governing body for the purpose of receiving comments and recommendations of interested individuals residing within the municipality relative to my client's application. In addition, the City Council must render a decision within 45 days of the request. In our experience before your Honorable Council, the hearings have been conducted at a legislative forum to ascertain whether moving the license into the City at a particular location would adversely affect the welfare, health, peace and morals of the municipality. Typically, the hearings have not been specially listed at their own times, but have been specially listed agenda items of regular City business. Further, the hearings have been conducted as the first order of business. We would respectfully request that this matter be listed on the next available City Council agenda in order to permit our client and the City to meet their legal requirements.

The proposed site is located at 29 Trembley Drive, Bethlehem on the campus of Lehigh University, and I welcome the City Council to review zoning records in this regard. My client is a wholly owned subsidiary of Lehigh University and will operate an on-campus restaurant and pub at the site. We have also provided the draft Pa.L.C.B. Transfer Application and the proposed Notice of the hearing to be posted at the premises. Please note that based on our Northampton County buffer search the only property owners within a 500-foot radius of the proposed property are all owed by Lehigh University (see attached). We will have the property

posted as required, but under the circumstances do not believe forwarding notice to Lehigh University is required. If you believe differently, please advise. Should you have any questions, concerns, or need any additional information regarding my client's proposal prior to the hearing, please do not hesitate to contact me. Lastly, attached is a copy of the proposed Resolution approving the transfer.

We are also providing a check in the amount of \$200.00 representing the City's required fees. If additional fees are required, please advise and we will promptly forward the same.

Additional information regarding the applicant will be provided upon request. Please confirm when my client's request is scheduled to be heard by Bethlehem City Council. By copy of this correspondence, we are providing Brian Panella, City Council Solicitor, of this request.



RESOLUTION NO. 2023 -

WHEREAS, Section 461 of the Pennsylvania Liquor Code (47 P.S. 4-461, hereinafter "Code") authorizes, among other things, the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board (hereinafter "PLCB") to approve the transfer of liquor licenses across municipal boundaries within the same county and under certain conditions to issue restaurant and eating place retail dispenser licenses without regard to quota restrictions for the purpose of economic development; and

WHEREAS, subsection (b.3) of Section 461 requires that an intermunicipal transfer or issuance of a new license for economic development must, under certain conditions, first be approved by the governing body of the receiving municipality; and

WHEREAS, that subsection also requires that a receiving municipality issue a resolution approving or disapproving the intermunicipal transfer or issuance of a new liquor license prior to submission of an application for such transfer to the PLCB; and

WHEREAS, that subsection mandates that, prior to adoption of such a resolution, at least one hearing be held for the purpose of receiving comments and recommendations from interested individuals residing within the receiving municipality concerning the intent to transfer the license into the municipality or the issuance of an economic development license; and

WHEREAS, CUC Holdings, LLC owns or leases property located at 29 Trembley Drive, Bethlehem, Northampton County, PA and intends to operate a fine dining but casual restaurant at such location; and

WHEREAS, on _______, 2023 and pursuant to Section 461, the Applicant's request was received for approval by City Council, City of Bethlehem, Northampton County (hereinafter "Council") of a proposed intermunicipal transfer of Retail Restaurant Liquor License No. R-18119. The license was previously issued to Everything is Beautiful, Inc. for licensed premises located at 665-669 Northampton Street, Easton, Northampton County; and

WHEREAS, on _______, 2023 and in accordance with Section 461 (b .3) Council held a public hearing on the proposed liquor license transfer; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Resolution is to comply with Code Section 461 (b.3).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bethlehem, Northampton County, Pennsylvania as follows:

- 1. Applicant seeks approval of an intermunicipal transfer of Retail Restaurant Liquor License No. R-18119 which was previously issued to Everything is Beautiful, Inc., for licensed premises located at 665-669 Northampton Street, Easton, Northampton County to 29 Trembley Drive, Bethlehem, Northampton County, Pennsylvania, pursuant to Code Section 461.
- 2. Applicant proposes to, and will, operate an on-campus restaurant and pub at the aforedescribed location.
 - 3. The Applicant's proposal is a permitted use at this location.
 - 4. The Applicant's proposed restaurant is in an Institutional zoning district.
- 5. There is no evidence that the proposed, intermunicipal transfer will adversely affect the welfare, health, peace and morals of this City or the residents hereof.
- 6. Council hereby approves the Applicant's request for an intermunicipal transfer of Pennsylvania Liquor License No. R-18119 pursuant to Code Section 461 (b.3).
- 7. The transfer of the Liquor License contemplated hereby is subject to final approval by the PLCB.
