Contracted emergency on-call service for repair of water distribution and wastewater collection system infrastructure and any related facilities on an as-needed basis. These services may be required when City personnel are unable to complete repair tasks due to the unavailability of personnel, insufficient equipment, and/or the need for specialty services.

• State the actual or estimated price to the City or the proposed Department budget allowance for the initial term; and state payment rate per unit of service if applicable:

Unit prices for labor and equipment were submitted with each bid which will offer a degree of certainty and control on expenses for the contract year. Once an event occurs that warrants the services of the contractor, a quote will be solicited using their unit pricing. Total cost for each job will depend on the nature and extent of the service to be provided. Cost for each emergency response can range from \$20,000 to \$100,000+.
