Resolution for DCNR Grant for South Bethlehem Greenway Extension

Attached are two resolutions in support of grant applications to the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR). The first resolution is for the extension of the South Bethlehem Greenway to the Saucon Rail Trail. We are requesting a grant in the amount of \$1.8 million as an additional funding source for acquisition of land, engineering and construction of the Greenway trail from Clark Street to Auburn Street, between Hellertown Road and Saucon Creek.

The second resolution is for the rehabilitation of Friendship Park. We are requesting a grant in the amount of \$250,000 as one funding source to begin park improvements that will enhance the visitors' experience and align with our Northside Alive neighborhood revitalization plan.
