• Description of project or scope of services to be provided:

Each year, the Greater Lehigh Valley Chamber of Commerce provides marketing and public relations services to the City through its management and operation of the Bethlehem Chamber of Commerce. The Bethlehem Chamber of Commerce maintains the Bethlehem Chamber Board and its committees, including the Citizen's Christmas City Committee (CCCC), the Bethlehem Marketing Council (BMC), and all associated committees existing or formed as needed; and the Downtown Bethlehem Association (DBA) and all associated committees existing or formed as needed. The Bethlehem Chamber of Commerce also carries out the management and implementation of marketing events geared toward strengthening the City of Bethlehem's visitor draw and local businesses' visibility and viability.

Funding from the City of Bethlehem is allocated to the following activities:

- A. Administration of Bethlehem Chamber of Commerce. Administration and overhead related to execution of management activities of the Bethlehem Chamber of Commerce, which includes staff salaries and operating expenses.
- B. Activities and Initiatives of the BMC. Website development and implementation of marketing plan and activities related to advertising and promotion, which includes reimbursement for third-party vendors and services.
- C. Integration of DBA & BMC. Support for the Downtown Bethlehem Association intended to ensure integration of Bethlehem Chamber of Commerce initiatives with DBA initiatives.
- D. Execution of City-Sponsored Events. Carry out certain City-sponsored events that fall within the spirit of the Bethlehem Chamber of Commerce purpose, such as the Live in the Garden music series, which includes reimbursement for third-party vendors and services.
- E. Waive Right of Way Fees for events and festivals.
- F. Compensation for other projects as assigned in connection with Execution of City-Sponsored Events.
