This block, between Northampton Street and Brodhead Avenue, will experience significant change with the construction of a new community cultural center by ArtsQuest and a new multi-unit, mixed-use residential building.

The grant project will address current safety and connectivity concerns on West Third Street by replacing the deteriorating sidewalk and curbing on portions of the street, installing streetscape amenities, and by updating and improving the crosswalk at the West Third Street and Broadhead Avenue intersection. Safe and inviting streetscapes help reduce local automobile traffic by encouraging people to walk to their destinations, thereby improving public health, stimulating local economic activity, and attracting residents and visitors to the South Bethlehem community.
