The new work shall be differentiated from the old and will be compatible with historic material, features, size, scale and proportion, and massing to protect the integrity of the historic property and its environment.

#10 New additions and adjacent or related new construction will be undertaken in such manner that, if removed in the future, the essential form and integrity of the historic property and its environment would be unimpaired.

- Regular historic door and entrance maintenance, repair, and repainting with historically appropriate paint colors
- Installing screen and storm doors, if needed, that are stylistically appropriate for the existing door
