The selected artist will work with Northside Alive, ty of Bethlehem, neighborhood Schools and the community to develop a cohesive		

community driven design. This will be a 20-day on-site residency, with 3-4 planning

days for the artist. A residency day is considered at least 1-hour and max. 3-hours a day. The artist does not need to work with the core group all three hours, i.e the artist works with the group one-hour and independently another hour. Several of these hours may be used during the community design process this winter while a majority of the on-site hours will be held in the spring. The artist will communicate with the neighborhood coordinator to create a schedule for community engagement workshops and plan out on-site dates. The artist is responsible for obtaining all needed supplies such as but not limited to paint, brushes, drop cloths and rags for the project. The goal is to have the artist engage with the community during the winter months to develop and prepare a community mural with a large portion of the implementation & installation of the Mural occurring in the beginning of 2024.
