• Description of project or scope of services to be provided:

The City applied for a Choice Neighborhood Planning Grant in June of 2023 and was awarded \$500,000 in September of 2023.

COLLABO will act as the City's planning coordinator for its Choice grant for the Stefko/Pembroke Community and produce a Choice Neighborhoods Transformation Plan. Over the two-year planning process, COLLABO will conduct extensive community engagement in the Stefko/Pembroke neighborhood, help form and run a project steering committee and conduct other critical planning functions to develop a Choice Neighborhood Plan centered with feasible actions for People, Housing and Neighborhood improvements. COLLABO will produce and submit a final plan to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and assist the City in executing the next steps of the implementation process.

COLLABO will also subcontract with other organizations for the market study and community ambassador training aspects of the planning process.

The Choice Neighborhoods grant will pay for \$290,000 of this contract, while \$30,000 of the City's match will cover the two additional contract components.

Choice Neighborhood Planning Grants were identified as an affordable housing strategy via the City's Comprehensive Housing Strategy Process. The City applied for a Choice Neighborhood Planning Grant in June of 2023 and was awarded \$500,000 in September of 2023.

The two-year planning grant helps communities develop comprehensive neighborhood transformation plans to update distressed public housing.

COLLABO was part of our Comprehensive Housing Strategy team. The firm has extensive experience applying for both planning and implementation grants with an impressive track record. COLLABO has led 11 successful Choice Neighborhood Plans and is currently the planning coordinator for three cities, including Harrisburg. Pa. COLLABO just completed Easton's planning grant and is moving them, and another community, into the implementation phase. Two communities where COLLABO led the planning process were recently awarded Choice Neighborhood Implementation grants ranging from \$30 million and \$50 million.
