This proposed contract would secure the professional services of a historic preservation specialist to carry out historic reviews necessary for many federally-funded projects funded with CDBG and other federal sources. Federally-funded activities carried out by the City and/or non-profit organizations generally require a HUD 24 CFR Part 58 environmental review. HUD environmental reviews often include a Section 106 historic review component that must be conducted by a historic preservation specialist pursuant to a programmatic agreement between the City and the PA State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO).

• State the actual or estimated price to the City or the proposed Department budget allowance for the initial term; and state payment rate per unit of service if applicable:

This contract includes an average cost per unit. Each unit is one property or project subject to a Section 106 historic review related to a HUD 24 CFR Part 58 environmental review.

• Number of renewal term options and duration of each renewal, if any:

One two (2) year City renewal option (January 1, 2027-December 31, 2028)

- Maximum dollar value of all renewals provided for beyond the original term as if all renewals were exercised: \$19,720: (January 1, 2027-December 31, 2028)

HUD requires the City to perform a historic review of many federally-funded activities as part of applicable 24 CFR Part 58 environmental reviews. The PA State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) has agreed that Artefact, Inc. is an appropriate substitute to the State Office of Historic Preservation review for conducting Section 106 historic reviews for federally-funded projects.
