Consultant shall provide professional services to assist the City water department with service line inventory and lead service line replacement planning in accordance with USEPA and PADEP regulatory requirements. The goal is to identify service line material for all 37,000 Bethlehem water customers and develop a plan to replace all lead services within the time frame established by regulatory agencies.
