RE: City Streets Cartway and Right-of-Way Widths

DATE: October 13, 2025


The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) requires an ordinance describing the legal cartway and right-of-way (ROW) widths of all City streets affected by the Linden Street Two Way Conversion project and the Broad Street Corridor Improvement project. A list of all known cartway and ROW widths for all City streets has been prepared to satisfy this PennDOT requirement for these projects, as well as any future projects. This list proposes no changes, and contains the same widths as are noted in the City's block and ward maps.

The public hearing for this proposed ordinance is scheduled for City Council's October 21, 2025 Meeting.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BETHLEHEM,
COUNTIES OF LEHIGH AND NORTHAMPTON,
COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, LISTING
CARTWAY AND RIGHT-OF-WAY WIDTHS FOR
CERTAIN CITY STREETS.

WHEREAS, portions of the Streets listed herein, having been previously dedicated or conveyed to the City of Bethlehem for street purposes have been paved with a bituminous surfacing by the City of Bethlehem and opened for public use and travel; and

WHEREAS, a formal record of the cartway and right-of-way widths of the listed City Streets is required by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHLEHEM HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the following portions of Streets situate within the City of Bethlehem, having been dedicated or conveyed to the City for street purposes and having been paved with a bituminous surface, have the following right-of-way and cartway widths, as established by the City's block and ward maps or ordinances, whichever is more up to date:
