**A RESOLUTION RE-APPOINTING ONE VOTING DELEGATE AND ONE ALTERNATE
TO SERVE AS THE CITY OF BETHLEHEM'S REPRESENTATIVES
TO THE NORTHAMPTON COUNTY TAX COLLECTION COMMITTEE**

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Bethlehem as follows:

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Act 32 of 2008 was established to reform the current Earned Income Tax (EIT) collection system by consolidating 560 EIT collectors into 69 Tax Collection Districts (TCD), formed mainly along county boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the TCD will be governed by a Tax Collection Committee (TCC) comprised of representatives of each of the municipalities and school districts within the TCD; and

WHEREAS, Act 32 505(b) requires the governing bodies of school districts, townships, boroughs, and cities that impose an EIT to appoint one voting delegate and one or more alternate delegate to be the Tax Collection Committee (TCC) representatives, and the City of Bethlehem desires to appoint the required delegates to represent its interests; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Bethlehem, Northampton County, Pennsylvania, that the following individuals are appointed as TCC delegates for the City of Bethlehem for 2026 and will exercise their duties on the City's behalf in the following manner:

1. Primary voting delegate: Linnea Lazarchak;
2. Alternate voting delegate: Eric R. Evans;
3. If the primary voting delegate cannot be present for a TCC meeting, the alternate voting delegate shall be the City's representative at the TCC meeting; and
4. These appointments are effective immediately and shall continue until successors are appointed by Resolution of the Council of the City of Bethlehem. All delegates shall serve at the pleasure of the Council of the City of Bethlehem and may be removed at any time.
