A Climate Action Plan (CAP) addresses climate change by promoting resilience through mitigation strategies that reduce greenhouse gas emissions such as increased energy efficiency, and through adaptation strategies that help the community prepare for the impacts of climate change such as stormwater runoff improvements for flood prevention.

**The City and consultant WSP will present a draft of Bethlehem's climate action plan, including its objectives, strategies, and proposed implementation approach.**

**The plan addresses a range of sectors, from buildings to transportation to education, with a focus on environmental justice considerations. A period of public comment on the draft will follow the virtual meeting. Share your thoughts on what is included in the plan.**
