1. **Main Street and Ohio Road (World Heritage Site)**

The Applicant proposes to install two (24" x 30") signs set in aluminum frames supported by a center aluminum post, both powder coated black and mounted at an obtuse angle. The panels will be lit by solar-powered LED fixtures mounted at the top of the frames. The design concept recalls a Moravian iron hinge with its decorative scroll-like appearance.

2. **427 North New Street (Kemerer Museum of Fine Arts)**

The Applicant proposes to replace the slate roof on the southeast corner with GAF Slateline asphalt shingles in "Antique Slate" gray to match existing shingles.

3. **108-110 Wesley Street**

The Applicant proposes to replace the entry door with a period style exterior door from the existing house; with new painted wood frame, 12" sidelights, and a transom window above.

4. **518 Main Street**

The Applicant proposes to replace the windows on the second and third floors of the building. All windows will be white aluminum and double-hung.

OWNER/APPLICANT: Jennifer Burns
