
REASON FOR APPEAL:


Lehigh University was granted a footing and foundation permit on July, 2019 for the address of 73 University Drive, Bethlehem, PA. The permit number is 19030785 and was approved for design based on the standards for IBC 2009. This permit was for the Phase 2 of our new dormitories. Phase 1 was completed at the end of 2020.

Phase 2 was originally scheduled to begin in the summer of 2020. Due to the effects of COVID-19, the project was temporarily put on hold until the University could properly assess the impacts of COVID-19 on housing and the needs of the students.

Lehigh University is requesting an extension to the building permit for Phase 2 until a start date of September, 2022.
