### **SALDO DISCUSSION**

### Planning Commission meeting February 10, 2022

Key Points for discussion regarding administrative provisions of the ordinance:

- Clarification of procedure for submission of all types of plans
- Incorporate Climate Action Goals into SALDO.
- Lanta and EAC formally included in the Plan Review Process.
- Definitions between SALDO and Zoning Ord are made consistent.
- Streamline Lot Consolidation procedure.

Key points related to Section 1349, Design Standards and Required Improvements

- Access Management provisions are added
- Provisions to reduce impervious paving or other surfaces are added along with allowance for porous surfaces in some situations
- Pedestrian, bike and transit improvements are enhanced and broadened
- Section is added specifically for traffic calming and crosswalks
- Public transit access provisions are added
- Coordination with other plans (Vision Zero, Climate Action, Trail Feasibility, etc.) required
- Native species required
- Green stormwater section added
- Specifications for bumpouts are added
- Provisions added for porous pavers around street trees
- Provisions for pathways and/or bikeways added.
