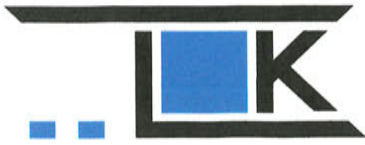

NARRATIVE

IN SUPPORT OF VARIANCE APPLICATION FOR 605 W. GOEPP ST.

The yard requirement for which a variance is being sought, is the side facing W. Spruce St.
