



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

#### 4. **DESCRIBE PROJECT:**

Historic Bethlehem Museums & Sites (HBMS) has secured funding to replace the failing and inappropriate deck with egress steps at the South Elevation of the 1869 Luckenbach Mill with simple egress steps constructed with pressure-treated wood and composite materials along with tubular steel handrails to match the existing entrance ramp and steps at the North Elevation. The proposed project will resolve the failing existing deck while unifying the exterior appearance of both elevations. Proposed materials will also withstand nuisance flooding and occasional major flooding events within the Colonial Industrial Quarter. Work is anticipated to begin in late spring / early summer of 2023.
