### THE JOSEPH H. TRAEGER HOUSE




Built circa 1860

Joseph H. Traeger was born on March 14, 1837, into a pioneer Moravian family and educated at the Moravian Parochial School. After over a decade of working as a clerk, Traeger and a partner purchased a mercantile store located across from The Sun Inn that became known as Seaman and Traeger, selling dry goods. Joseph was active in civic and religious activities throughout his life. As a member of the Board of Trade, he encouraged new businesses to locate in Bethlehem. He served twice in the Civil War. As a corporal in 1863, he survived the Battle of Gettysburg. His son Charles served as a colonel in the Spanish American War.

Joseph's first two wives predeceased him. His third wife, Cornelia M. Hammann, bore him two girls and two boys. Joseph H. Traeger died on August 18, 1905, and is buried in nearby Nisky Hill Cemetery in Section D with other family members.
