Originally built as a log home around the late 1780's to 1796 it was one of the few TWO STORY log homes ever built in Pennsylvania. Built on land giving to the son of William Penn, the founder of Pennsylvania which was actually taken from the Iroquois during the "walking purchase".

It was a stagecoach stop when the country road was one of the only roads in Pennsylvania. In the 1920s it was moved from one area to where it currently is to make way for the widening of the road. Since then it has served as Waltz's general store and home to countless families.





It is likely the oldest surviving home in Monroe County, Pennsylvania. We sustained a terrible fire in our beloved home that we have lovingly cared for and renovated
